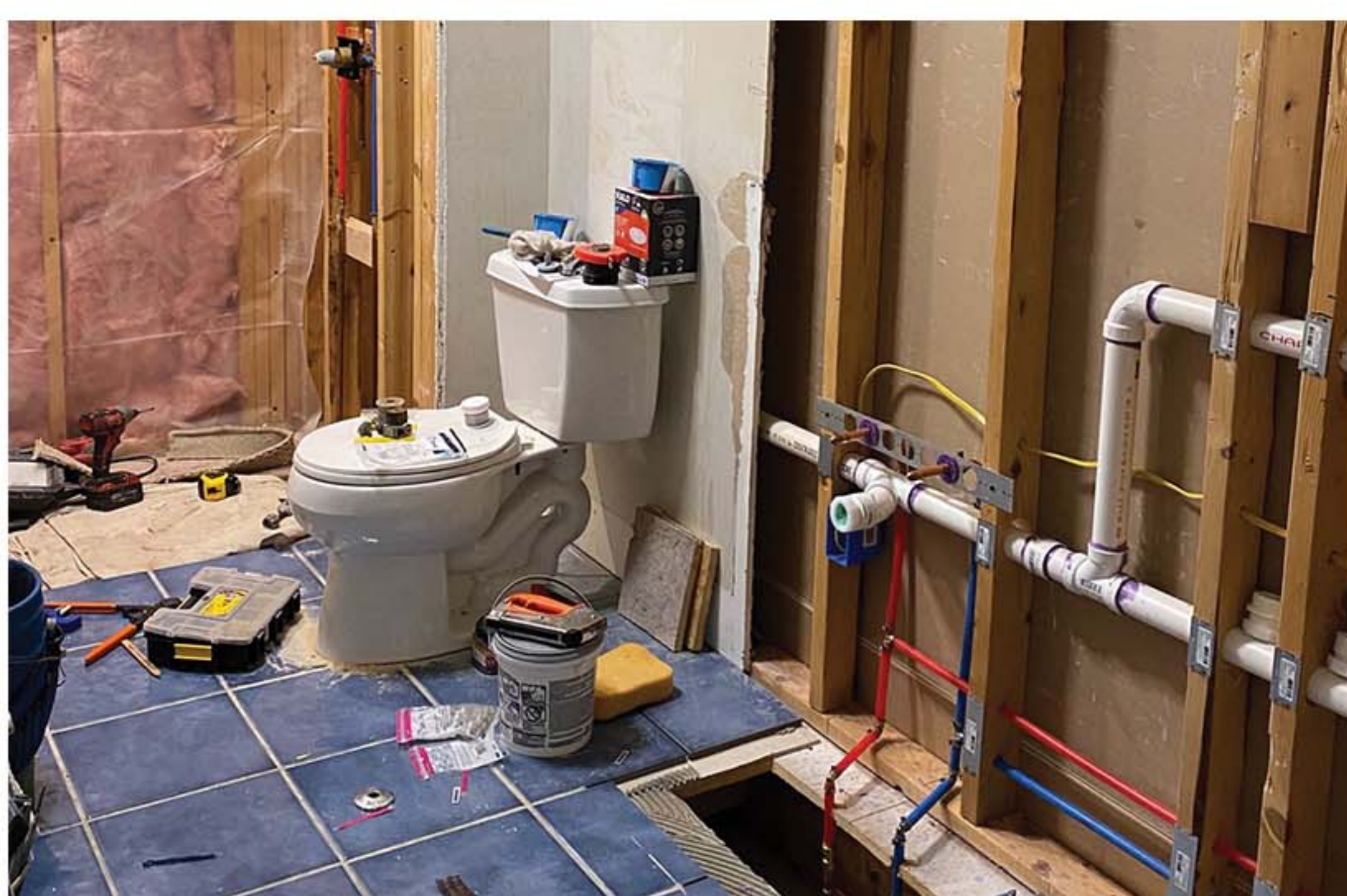

EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED

Bumps along the way will happen. Be prepared by allowing for extra time on the timeline, money in the budget, and understanding. Examples include:

- Unexpected concealed items such as rot or water damage exposed during demolition
- Special order items that will have to be ordered
- Products that arrive damaged and must be returned
- Fixing existing items that may not have been installed correctly in the first place
- Counter tops that have to be measured for on site
- Weather delays

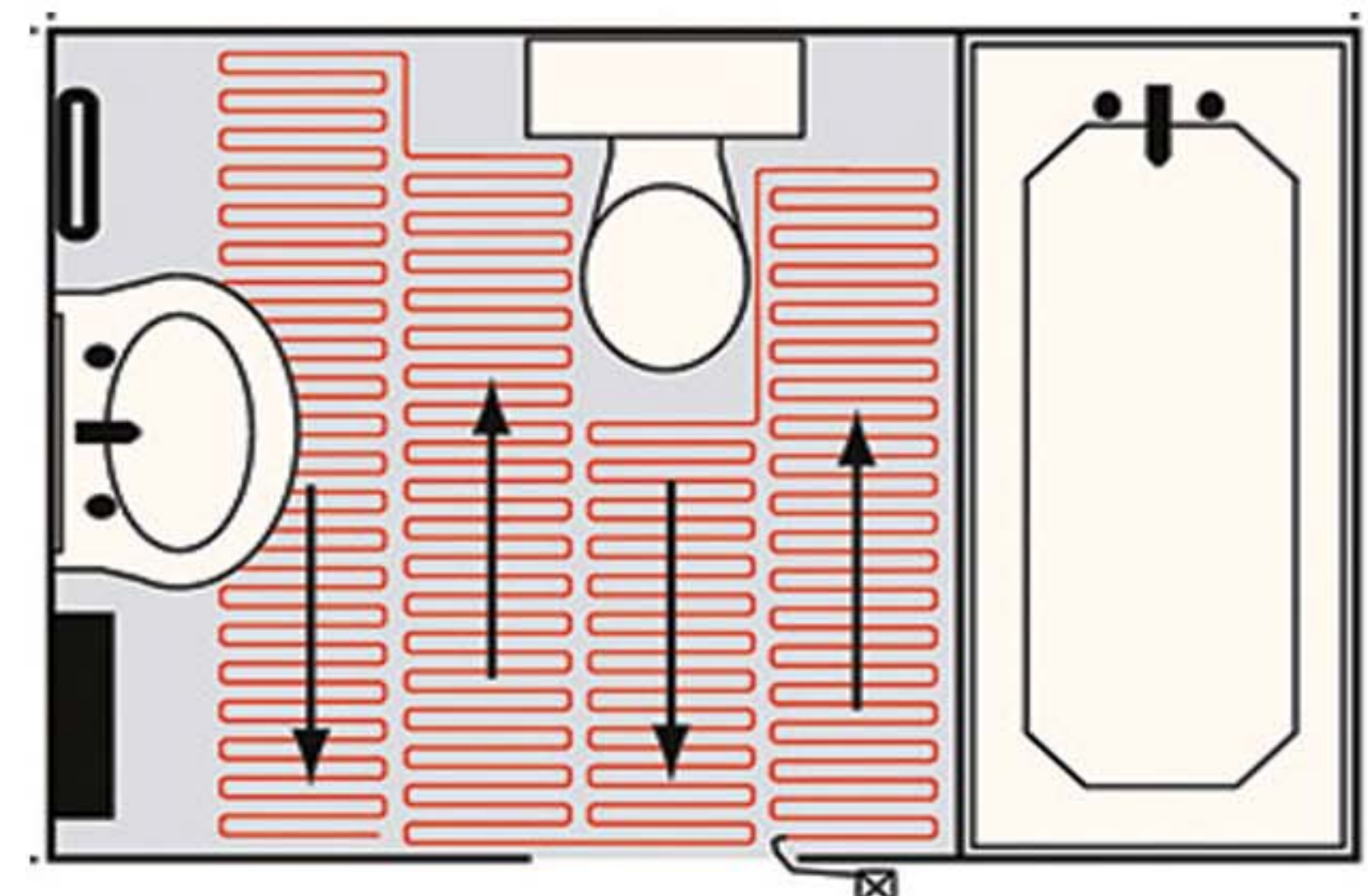
